Outreach Policy 2011-2012

Each student senator shall be required to earn a minimum of 100 outreach points in the fall semester and 100 outreach points in the spring semester. The following list displays how senators earn outreach points.

1) Hold an Outreach planning meeting with senators of your same constituency	5 points (10 point max)
2) Beginning of semester outreach emails, (cc the Outreach Director) (mandatory)	10 points
3) Speak at assigned organizations about how to get Senate funding	g 10 points each
4) Attend a Student Senate funded event and turn in event sheet	10 points each
5) Author a piece of legislation for Student Senate	20 points each
6) Give a pro/neg speech on legislation during full Senate	20 points each
7) Attend an approved CCO event	(40 max) 10 points each
8) Attend an approved SLAB event	20 points each
9) Table for Student Senate	10 points
10) Speak at organizations to promote freshman elections/the JayLEAD Program	(per hour) 10 points each
11) Participate in a Student Senate affiliated community service project	20 points each
12) Lead a public forum of students within your constituency (Verify with the Outreach Director)	20 points
13) Meet with an administrator of your constituency to discuss their collaboration with Student Senate (verify with Outreach Director beforehand)	20 points (limit once per semester)
14) Make a classroom announcement about approved Senate events	5 points each (20 pt limit)
15) Going above and beyond the norm in representing (at the discretion of the Outreach Director)	0-20 points each

Tracking Points:

Each week, the Outreach Director will update the monthly and overall point charts which can be found in the student senate office. With this chart, Student Senators will be able to determine how many points they need in order to fulfill their semester outreach responsibilities. Each Student Senator must complete a minimum of 35 points by the end of the third legislative cycle of each semester. If this requirement has not been met by said date, the Senator will be called to meet with the Chief of Staff to discuss a plan of action. Any additional opportunities to receive points will be posted next to the point charts.

Student Senators, in order to receive credit for their outreach efforts, must email the Outreach Director within 3 days of completion.
